18 RESIDENCY INFORMATION - MUST BE COMPLETED

The information you furnish will be used to determine whether you qualify as a California resident. Nonresidents will be required to pay non-resident tuition. Generally, residency requires that you must have lived in California with the clear intent of becoming a permanent resident for at least one year and a day prior to the first day of instruction for the term in which you are enrolling. The burden of proof to clearly demonstrate both physical presence in California and intent to establish California residence lies with the student.

Documentation may include two of the following: California driver's license or identification card, bank statement, voter registration, letters from employers or governmental agencies, rent receipts, or transcripts from California schools. There are certain exceptions to this rule which apply to military personnel and their dependents, or in the case of certain students below 19 years of age, etc. You may be required to supply additional information to determine your residency status. Such information might be evidence in accordance with Education Code Sections 68040 et sec.
